Free Rabies Vaccination Clinic

For Dogs and Cats

SATURDAY, MAY 17, 2008

11:00 a.m. until 2:00 p.m.

Free rabies vaccination clinic Saturday, May 17, 2008 at the Multi-Service Center. All dogs must be securely fastened with a collar and leash. Dog owners must first obtain a 2008 Hoboken dog license on site.

PROOF OF RESIDENCY IS REQUIRED

Please be aware that all dogs whose rabies vaccination expires at any point in 2008 will not be issued a 2008 dog license. Rabies vaccination must be valid for the entire year. It is recommended that dogs receive vaccination every 2 years. A veterinarian from the Animal Infirmary of Hoboken will administer the vaccine. Please take advantage of this opportunity to protect yourself and your pet against rabies.

- Dogs and cats brought to the clinic **must be on a leash or in a carrier and ACCOMPANIED BY AN ADULT** who will place the animal on the examining table
- Dogs must have a 2008 Hoboken license, attached to collar or harness
- License fees: **spayed/neutered**: \$10.00 **non-spayed/neutered**: \$14.00
